How long is the CultureMakers course?

CultureMakers runs every Wednesday at 9.30am over the course of 9 weeks, starting from 24 May 2023. Check out the calendar.

What's the format for each session?

The main sessions are hosted virtually and run for 90 minutes with a short break in the middle, the WTF sessions are 60 minutes. The final Meet the CultureMakers session will be in-person in London so you get to meet your cohort!

Who is running the course?

Our culture specialist JVH will run the main sessions, supported by fellow culture specialists Nikki and Heather who will host the WTF sessions.

How do the WTF sessions work?

The WTF sessions are designed to help you consolidate what you've learnt. Think of them as a check-in where you can ask a culture specialist and your peers for support.

Is the course accredited?

No right now, it's more about helping people like you get a solid foundation in company culture. But never say never ;)

How will I access the course?

Through our community platform - The Clubhouse. Don't worry, we'll get you set up and ready to go in plenty of time. All you need is a laptop!
